Studying in Aschaffenburg – list of expenditures

In order to apply for a visa or residence permit for Germany, students are generally required to present proof of financial resources. Currently, you are expected to demonstrate funds of 934 EUR per month / 11,208 EUR per year. The required blocked amount for a student visa application is dependent on the BAföG rate which will increase from October 2024 to 992 EUR per month. For further information, please contact the German Embassy or Consulate in your country of residence.
